Proper Footwear in the Gym

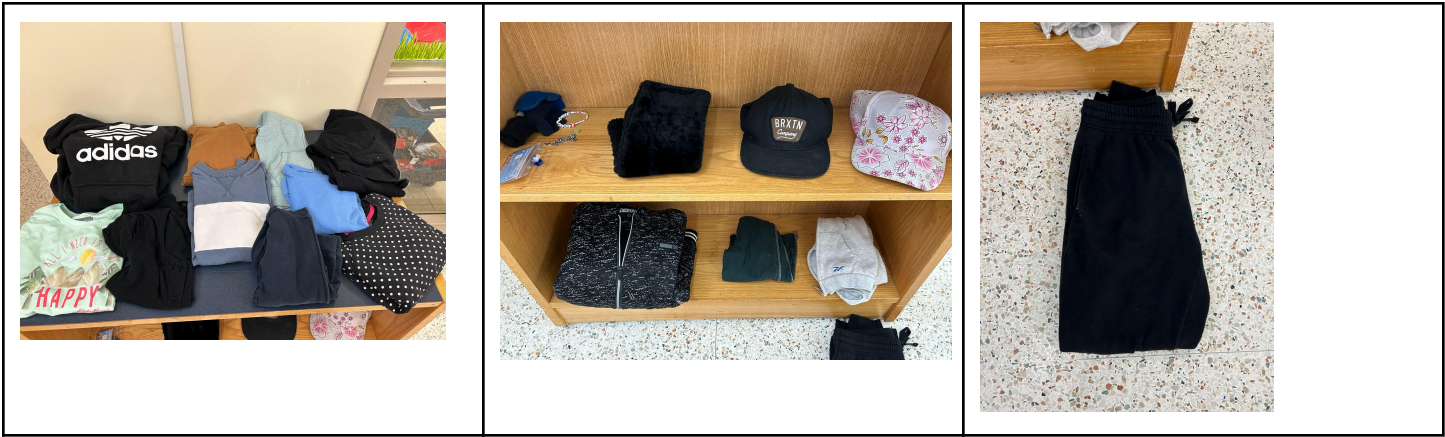
Please ensure your child has proper running shoes with a good sole/tread for participation in the gym. We have noticed many students in Crocs or other footwear that can lead to slips/falls.
